

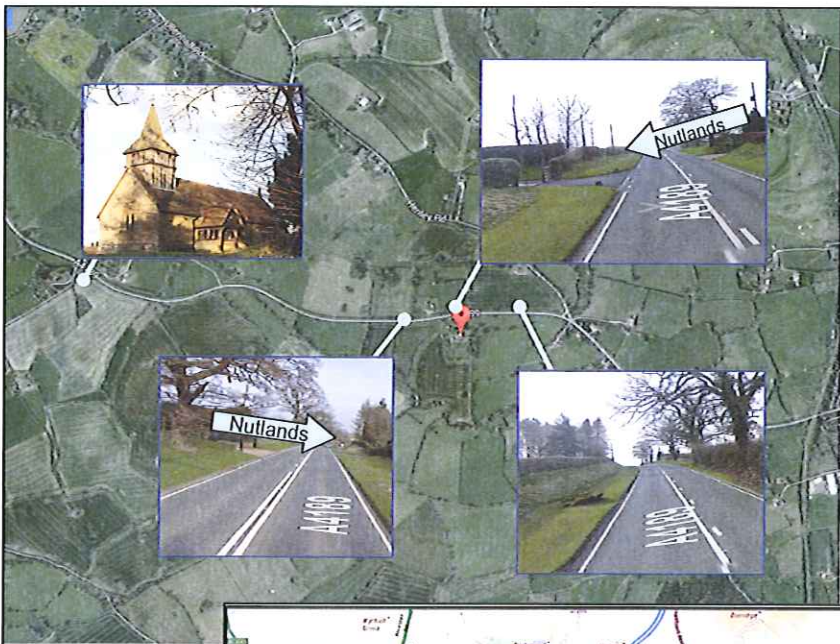
How to find the Nutlands

The Nutlands is on the A4189 between Henley in Arden and Redditch. See large scale map below for the location. The Post Code B95 5NH gives a clear location in GPS systems.

Coming South, take the A3400 to Stratford. This can be accessed via J16 on the M40. Continue through Henley village to the traffic lights and turn right.

Coming North on the M40, leave at J15 and take the exit to Stratford. At the first small roundabout keep right and follow the signs to Henley in Arden. At the T junction turn L onto the A4189 which will take you straight to the Henley traffic lights where you go straight over.

The Nutlands is just over 1 mile from the Henley cross roads, past the turning to Ullenhall up a slight hill. The drive on the LHS has a cattle grid and is marked by 2 stones. There is sign on the verge just before the entrance.



Coming East from Redditch join the A4189 at the roundabout with the A435. Follow the road for 3 miles, past Oldberrow Church. The Nutlands is just under a mile ahead round sweeping bends until the road climbs uphill. The drive is on the R just over the crest past a house called Greenacres on the L.
